## - Lip Sync -

Sunday, October 4, 2009  
7:00 p.m. in CUB Senior Ballroom

### Participation Form

Teams **must** turn in a completed participation form to the SEB Office in CUB 304 by **Wednesday, September 30 at 5:00 p.m.**

### Music

Teams will provide their own music on a CD. All music must be clearly marked with their team name/living group name. Music must be turned in to the SEB Office in CUB 304 by **Wednesday, September 30 at 5:00 p.m.**

Material submitted **CANNOT** be offensive in any way or contain any profanity. Any performance that portrays a negative racial or sexual stereotype will be immediately disqualified. This includes slurs and sexually explicit song lyrics.

### Lip Sync Performance

Set-up, performance and breakdown **MUST** be completed in **5 MINUTES!** Exceeding the time limit will result in a **five-point deduction** from final score.

Participation in the entire performance must consist of **no less than 3 members and no more than 7 team members. At least one male and one female** must participate in some capacity. Extra team members will result in disqualification. No exceptions.

Taste will be used when deciding costumes. **Five points will be deducted** from teams who dress in an untasteful manner. Please remember you are representing your living group and WSU.

No hazardous material is allowed (example: Water balloons, fire extinguishers, squirt guns, etc.). Any mess **MUST** be cleaned up during the breakdown and before the next performance.

All team participants (those participating in the Lip Sync) **MUST CHECK IN BY 6:15 p.m.** on the day of the Lip Sync. Failure to check in by this time will result in elimination from the Lip Sync. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

### **Judging**

Performance is based on tasteful costumes, props, creativity, originality, incorporation of the homecoming based theme and overall performance.

The team with the most points at the end of the competition will be the winner. The top three teams will be announced at the end of the lip sync competition.

**The winner will perform an encore performance of their lip sync routine at the Bon Fire on Friday, October 9, 2009.**

This year's Homecoming decorating competition is designed to liven up the campus and get everyone pumped for the week of Homecoming.

Teams will choose one location that they currently live-in (a residence hall, Greek house, student group office, etc.). Each group is encouraged to decorate an area that is seen by **more than 100 people per day**. This can include: yard, windows, roof, TV lounging areas, etc.

Decorating must be done by 2:00 p.m. on Monday. Judging will be from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

**Teams must complete an application and turn it in by Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> to the SEB Office (CUB 304).**

# TUESDAY

## - Photo Scavenger Hunt -

1. Teams will have **ONE HOUR** to complete the scavenger hunt list.
2. Two representatives from your team must be in all pictures.
3. Teams must **provide their own digital camera** that either has picture-viewing capabilities or provide us with a transfer cord to view on a computer.
4. No repeating people from different categories. For example, you may not use the same person for a UW shirt and a seashell necklace.
5. Cameras are **not allowed** in the library. Any pictures of books must be taken in front of the Nipple of Knowledge, showing that the book was checked out.
6. Teams cannot use one object for two categories. For example, a purple object cannot be used as a shoelace too.
7. **No inappropriate images**, i.e. breaking school rules, no nudity of any sort, no obscene gestures, etc.
8. Motorized vehicles may not be used for transportation purposes.
9. Groups must stay together.
10. Do not disturb people in classrooms, inside any buildings on campus or in study groups. **Ten points will be deducted if any complaints about your team are made.**
11. Teams must stay inside the boundaries. Teams found outside the boundaries will be disqualified.
12. Participants are allowed to take pictures inside the boundary lines labeled on the map you will receive the day of the hunt.

# WEDNESDAY

## - Serpentine -

**Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009**  
**6:00 p.m. beginning at Thompson Flats**

The Homecoming Serpentine will begin at Thompson Flats. It will proceed down Campus Street, turn on Opal Street, turn on Colorado Street and end at Martin Stadium.

Prior to the start of the Serpentine, the Chant Competition will be held. Teams must be prepared with their chants. See below for more details.

### While on the Serpentine

- A team member must check in the chariot for Games Night at the front gate of Martin Stadium. The chariot must be there **no later than 6:15 p.m.** Chariots will not be allowed on the Serpentine route.
- Take responsibility in avoiding traffic and other hazards along the route. WSU and Pullman Police will be assisting with diverting traffic, but you are responsible for yourself.
- No alcohol or drugs will be allowed.
- Please do not litter!
- If any damage to cars, public/private property, or signposts is done, your team will be disqualified from the Serpentine and Games Night. Please note that your team is representing WSU.

### Chant Competition

- Chant should be no more than **one minute long**.
- No loud speakers, amplifiers, or artificial noisemakers are allowed.
- Teams must turn in a typed copy of their chant to the SEB Office in the CUB room 304 by **Wednesday, September 23 at 5:00 p.m.** If we do not receive a copy of the chant, your team will not be able to compete in the competition.
- Please be prepared at any time. Judges will randomly have teams perform their chants.

- Scores are based on unity, enthusiasm, clarity, volume, creativity, and the homecoming theme.
- Yell out your team chants throughout the duration of the Serpentine route. Show your Cougar Spirit and Cougar Pride!

## **Scoring**

Each team will need to **collect a sheet** from a SEB or Street Team member at **5:45 p.m.** Each team member must write his or her name and student ID number down. These sheets must be given back to a SEB or Street Team member **before the Serpentine departs.**

# WEDNESDAY

## - Games Competition -

Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009

7:00 p.m

Martin Stadium

### Rules

- Teams are encouraged to sit together as a group.
- **Teams are liable** for damage caused to the section of the stadium they are sitting in. Vandalism or property destruction will result in an automatic disqualification from Games Night.
- Each team must clean their sitting area prior to leaving Martin Stadium. This includes removing and disposing of chairs and garbage. **Failure to do so will result in a 75-point deduction.** Please do **NOT** dispose of garbage in the tunnel.
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs of any kind are allowed.
- No fireworks, flames, flammable items, etc. Teams will be disqualified immediately from Games Night if caught with any of these items.
- No more than two representatives per team are allowed on the stadium floor when your team is not competing.
- Only those members of each team who are participating in the event are allowed on the stadium floor during competitions.
- Varsity football players are not allowed to participate in Games Night (this includes red shirt players).
- If a medical emergency arises during the games, please notify a SEB member immediately.
- If there are any questions or concerns during Games Night, please feel free to talk to any SEB member.
- **All players competing in any games must be wearing closed toed shoes.** Flip flops, bare feet, spikes and cleats are not allowed!
- **No jumping over/off of the railing will be allowed. There will be a 50 point deduction** for every person caught doing this.

## **Skin-The-Snake**

- Twenty team members will participate in this event: **10 male and 10 female.**
- Teams will stand in a single file line facing the scoreboard alternating male and female.
- Each participant reaches between their legs with their left hand and holds the right hand of the person behind them.
- **At the signal**, the last person, the tail of the snake, will lie down and the chain moves backward over them until the last person lies down.
- The last person's head must touch the ground before standing up and walking back over the snake, while pulling others up with them.
- Once the entire snake is standing it must slither (aka run) to the end zone, while remaining connected until the last person crosses the line (not just the first person).
- **IF THE CHAIN BREAKS, EACH TEAM MEMBER MUST STOP AND RETURN TO THE PLACE WHERE THE BREAK OCCURRED.** From there, the team must proceed. Failure to follow this will result in disqualification.
- All players must be wearing closed toed shoes.

## **Points for Skin-The-Snake**

1<sup>st</sup> Place: 150 Points  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 100 Points  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place: 50 Points  
Participation: 25 points

## **Tug-Of-War**

- 16 team members will participate in this event: **8 male and 8 female.**
- Teams alternate male and female participation along the rope.
- **Closed toed shoes must be worn.**
- **NO** hooks, lines, or sinkers may be used on the rope.
- All participants must keep their hands on the rope at all times and cannot begin pulling until the signal is given.
- Letting go of the rope results in a 100-point deduction.
- The rope cannot be wrapped around anyone except the anchor person (the end person).
- No one besides the 16 participants is allowed on the field or your team will be disqualified.

- Switching the original 16 participants on the Tug-Of-War team with other team members will not be allowed. If this happens, your team will be disqualified.
- **GLOVES are optional. You must provide them for your team.**

1<sup>st</sup> Place: 150 Points  
 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 100 Points  
 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: 50 Points  
 Participation: 25 points

### **Chariot Races**

- **Five women and five men** from each team will participate.
- Four female runners pull one male rider down the field, and then four male runners pull one female rider back.
- All chariots must have **two wheels ONLY**.
- All chariots must have four handles that cannot be flipped.
- All chariots must be able to push/pull from both sides.
- Chariots shall not exceed 12 feet in length and not less than 8 feet in length.
- **All wheels must be rubber. No bare rims!**
- **Padding must protect the riders and runners from sharp edges.**
- **The rider must have a handle in the chariot.**
- **Chariots must have sides to protect the rider from the wheels.**
- **All riders must wear PROTECTIVE HELMETS at all times.** Other protective clothing such as knee and elbow pads, long pants, and long sleeves are recommended. SEB will not provide helmets for your team.
- **Only closed toed running shoes can be worn.** Spikes, cleats, sandals, and bare feet are not allowed.
- The Chariot Race will be the last competition during Games Night in Martin Stadium.
- Heat assignments will be drawn and announced prior to the races.
- Female runners pulling the male rider will begin **FIRST** at the end zone underneath the scoreboard.
- The entire chariot must remain **behind the starting line** until the race begins.
- All four runners and the entire chariot **MUST** cross the end zone line before any switches are made. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

- All four runners and the entire chariot **MUST** cross the end zone line underneath the scoreboard before time is stopped.
- Teams cannot flip the chariot. **The chariot must be turned around completely in the end zone.**
- Teams must remain in their designated lanes.

## **Chariot Race Finals**

- The **four teams** with the fastest times will compete in the final race at halftime of the Homecoming Football Game on **Saturday, October 10<sup>th</sup>**.
- Only riders and runners are allowed on the field at halftime.

## **Chariot Race Scoring**

- First, second and third place points will be given to teams with the fastest times.
- Additional points will be given to the Most Creative Chariot. Chariots will be judged on creativity, theme, design, and functionality at the time they are to race.

### Rules

- **Two teams will be randomly paired together.** Both teams will not be from the same category (i.e. Student Group, Residence Hall, or Greek).
- Groups partnered together will each get points attributed to first, second and third place.
- Once assigned groups, you may not switch teams or groups.
- Teams must check in by **8:30 a.m.** with a SEB member or you will be disqualified for this event.
- Representatives for your jug of money may be rotated throughout the day. They **must sign in with a SEB member** or Street Team member prior to watching the money.
- There must be a representative with the team jug and the jug must remain on the table **at all times.** For example: You may not take a break for an hour and then come back, or take the jug and then come back.
- Pennies and dollars **increase** your amount.
- Silver coins **decrease** or count against your overall amount.
- **BANK ROLLED PENNIES EARN DOUBLE THE POINTS.**
- Teams are asked to **bring a sign** to hang on their table saying who they are and who they are supporting.

### Beneficiary

- Once two teams are paired together, they are asked to come up with a beneficiary they will be supporting.
- Their beneficiary must be reported to the SEB Office in CUB room 304 by **Tuesday, October 6<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.**
- The money raised will be donated to the beneficiary of the winning team of **Penny Wars alone (not all of Homecoming week).**
- Beneficiaries are **encouraged to be a part of the Pullman community,** but are not required.

- Booths need to be **set up and ready by 10:45 a.m.** Tables will be provided for you and set up by 10:00 a.m. Judging starts at 11:00 a.m. and will go until 1:00 p.m., so keep your booth up for the entire time.
